The Guyana Energy Conference and Supply Chain Expo is an annual event uniting industry leaders, policymakers, and stakeholders to explore developments and opportunities in energy and supply chains. The Conference's objective is to foster forward-looking discussions, bridging gaps and connecting ideas across borders and included workshops, panel discussions, and networking events, enabling direct engagement with peers and experts. 
